MN Boating Regulations

Personal watercraft (PWC) are also known as Jet Skis or Wave Runners. All personal watercraft are considered motorboats and therefore, any regulations that govern other motorboats (such as fishing boats, cabin cruisers, etc.), also govern watercraft.

Personal watercraft laws require that:

- Anyone operating or riding on a PWC must wear a U.S. Coast Guard-approved wearable life jacket that is compatible with that activity (check the label).
- PWC must travel at slow no-wake speed (5 mph or less) within 150 feet of non motorized boats, shore (unless launching or landing skiers directly to or from open water), docks, swim rafts, swimmers, or any moored or anchored boat.
- Operation of PWC is allowed only from 9:30 a.m. to one hour before sunset.
- If you tow a person on water skis or any other device, there must be an additional person on board the PWC to act as an observer.
- Boats are required to have lights between sunset and sunrise. Non-motorized boats must carry at least a white light, such as a flashlight, to display in time to avoid a collision with other watercraft. Motorboats, when moving, must have a red and green bow light and a white stern light that is visible from 360 degrees around the boat. If your motorboat is anchored you need to display only the 360-degree light.

Bob the Bug Guy
